

The UNIcert® Levels

The UNIcert® levels are oriented around the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

UNIcert® Basis

The initial skills necessary for the basic and direct exchange of information.

► Level A2 (Waystage) of the CEFR.

UNIcert® Level I

Extension of the initial skills which enable communication in the language of everyday life.

▶ Level B1 (Threshold) of the CEFR.

UNIcert® Level II

Language and intercultural competence which enables a study-related stay abroad (lowest level of mobility).

► Level B2 (Vantage) of the CEFR.

UNIcert® Level III

Language and intercultural competence which completely satisfies the requirements of being able to study abroad (recommended level of mobility). Language for specific purposes orientation (e.g. business or technology) is also available.

► Level C1 (Effective Operational Proficiency) of the CEFR.


UNIcert® Level IV
